Activities: As follows

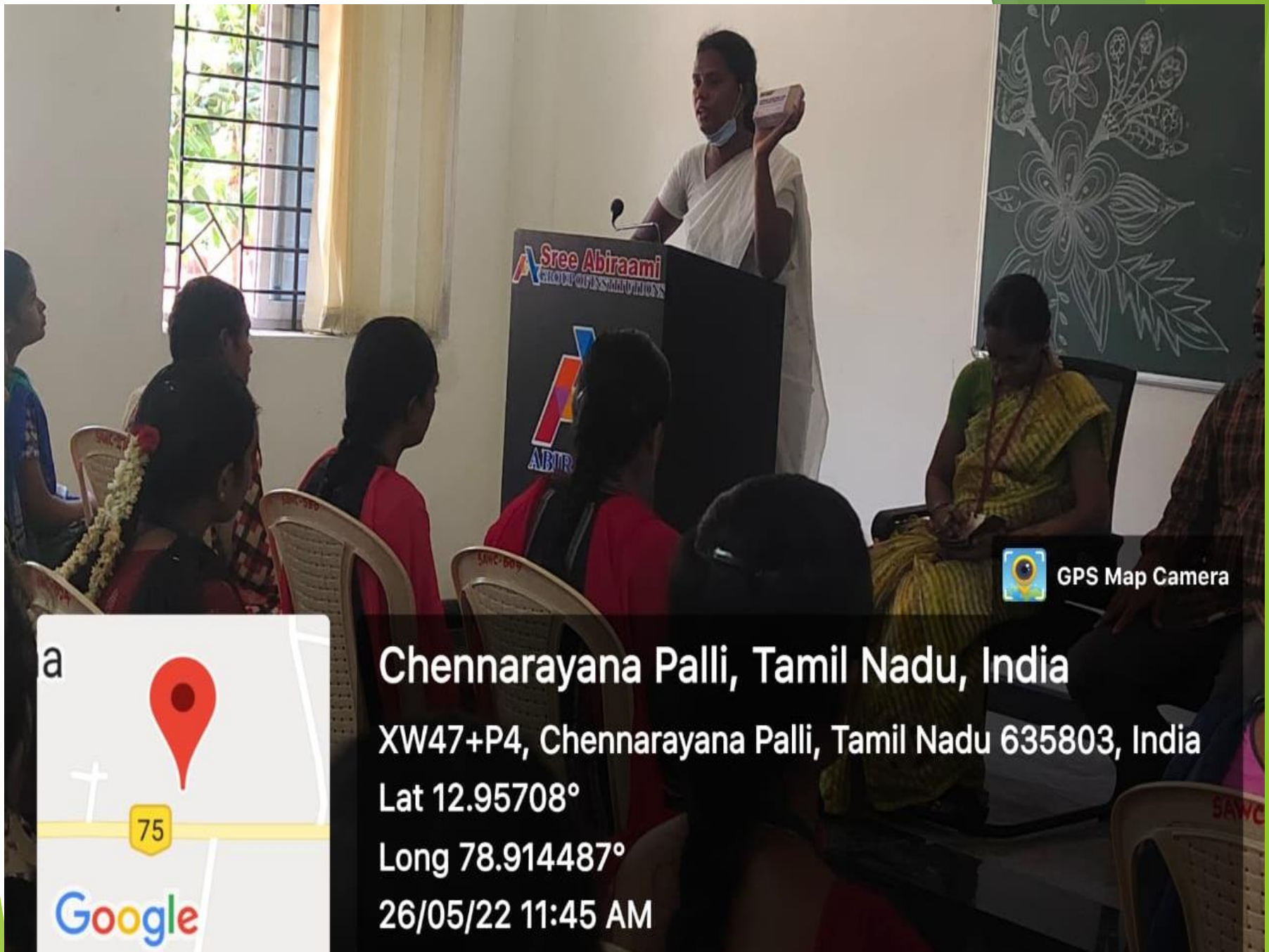
- RRC distributed Vitamin tablets to the students on 26th May, 2022.

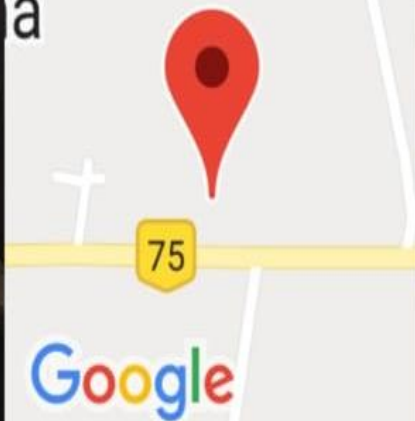
Distribution of Vitamin tablets to the students
